



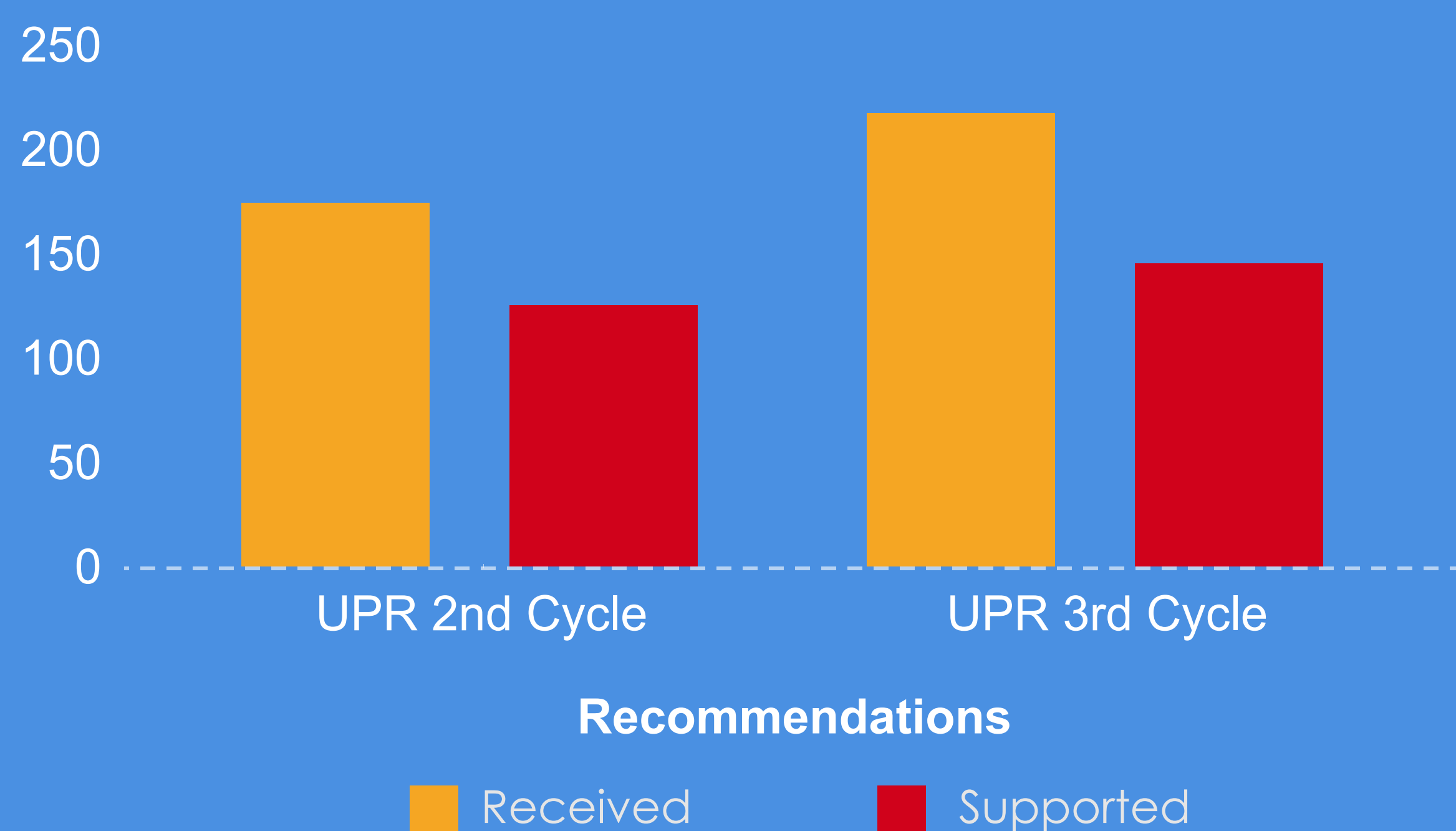

The Universal Periodic Review

Japan was reviewed by UPR WG 28, in November of 2017. Japan received 217 recommendations and it supported 145 recommendations at the adoption of its UPR outcome at HRC 37, in March 2018 (an increase of 16% with respect to the 2nd cycle).

Supported recommendations related to: Legal and general framework of implementation, universal and cross-cutting issues, civil and political rights, economic, social, and cultural rights, women's rights, and rights of other vulnerable groups and persons.

Top 5* Sustainable Development Goals



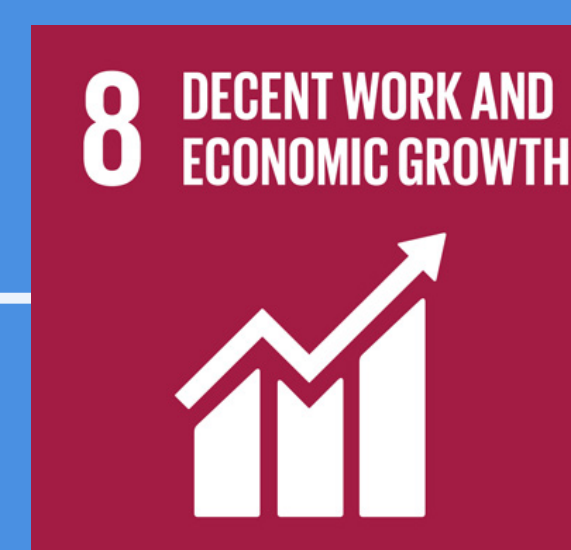

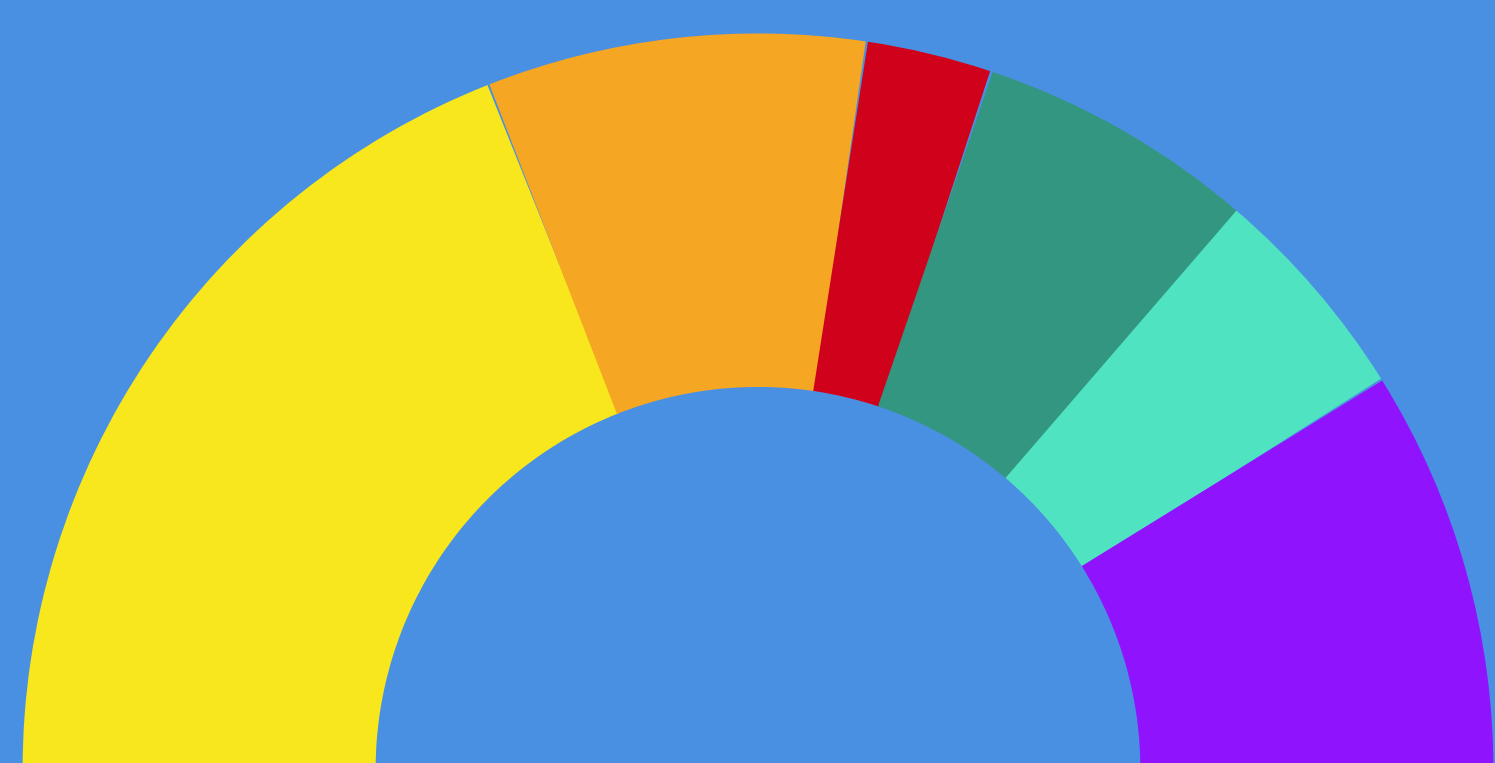
