



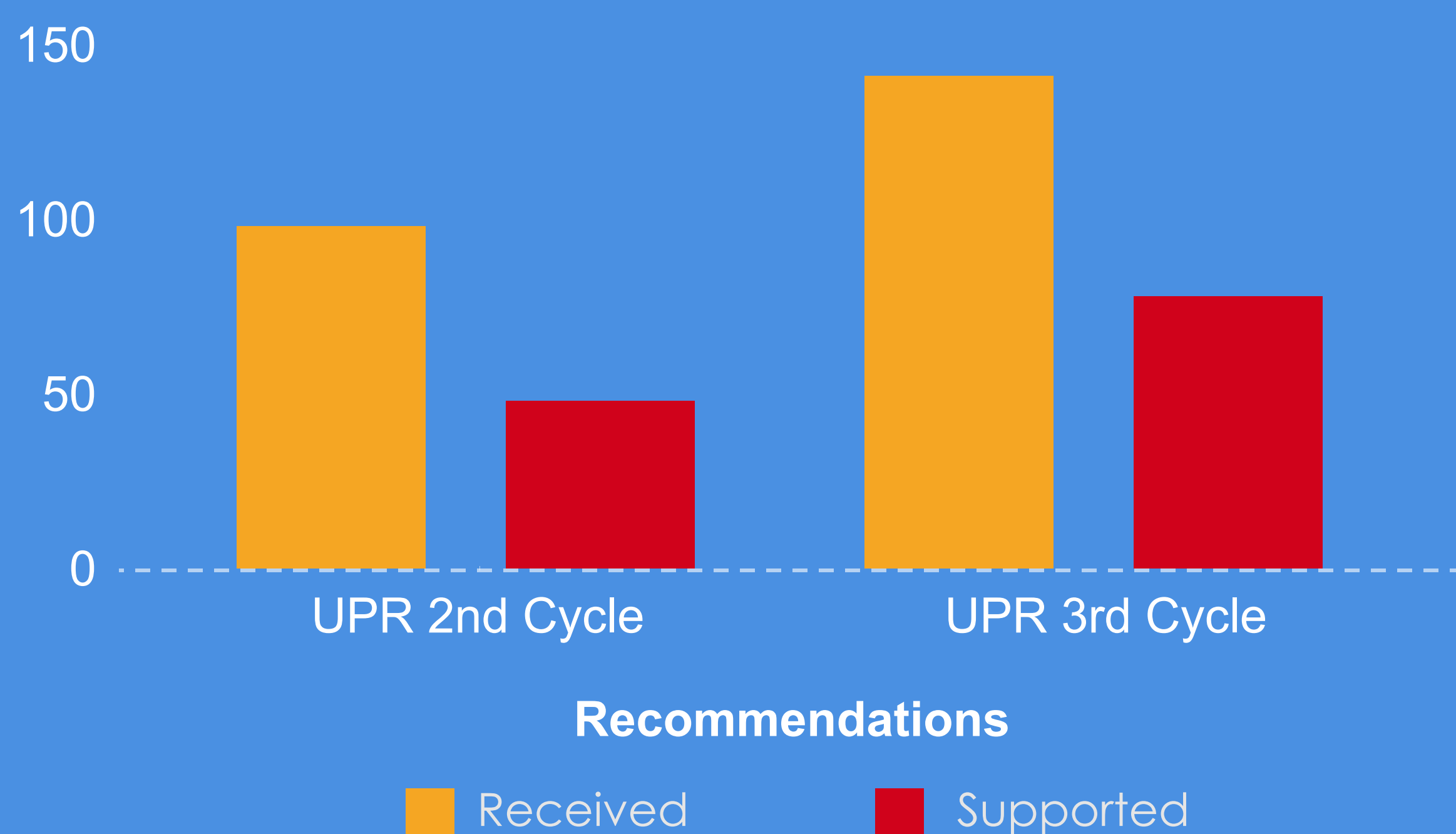
Bahamas

The Universal Periodic Review

Bahamas was reviewed by UPR WG 29, in January of 2018. Bahamas received 141 recommendations and it supported 78 recommendations at the adoption of its UPR outcome at HRC 38, in June 2018 (an increase of 63% with respect to the 2nd cycle).

Supported recommendations related to: Legal and general framework of implementation, universal and cross-cutting issues, civil and political rights, economic, social, and cultural rights, women's rights, and rights of other vulnerable groups and persons.

Top 5* Sustainable Development Goals



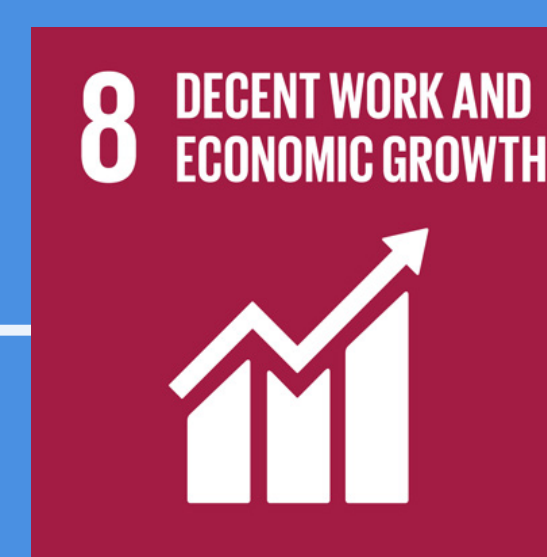

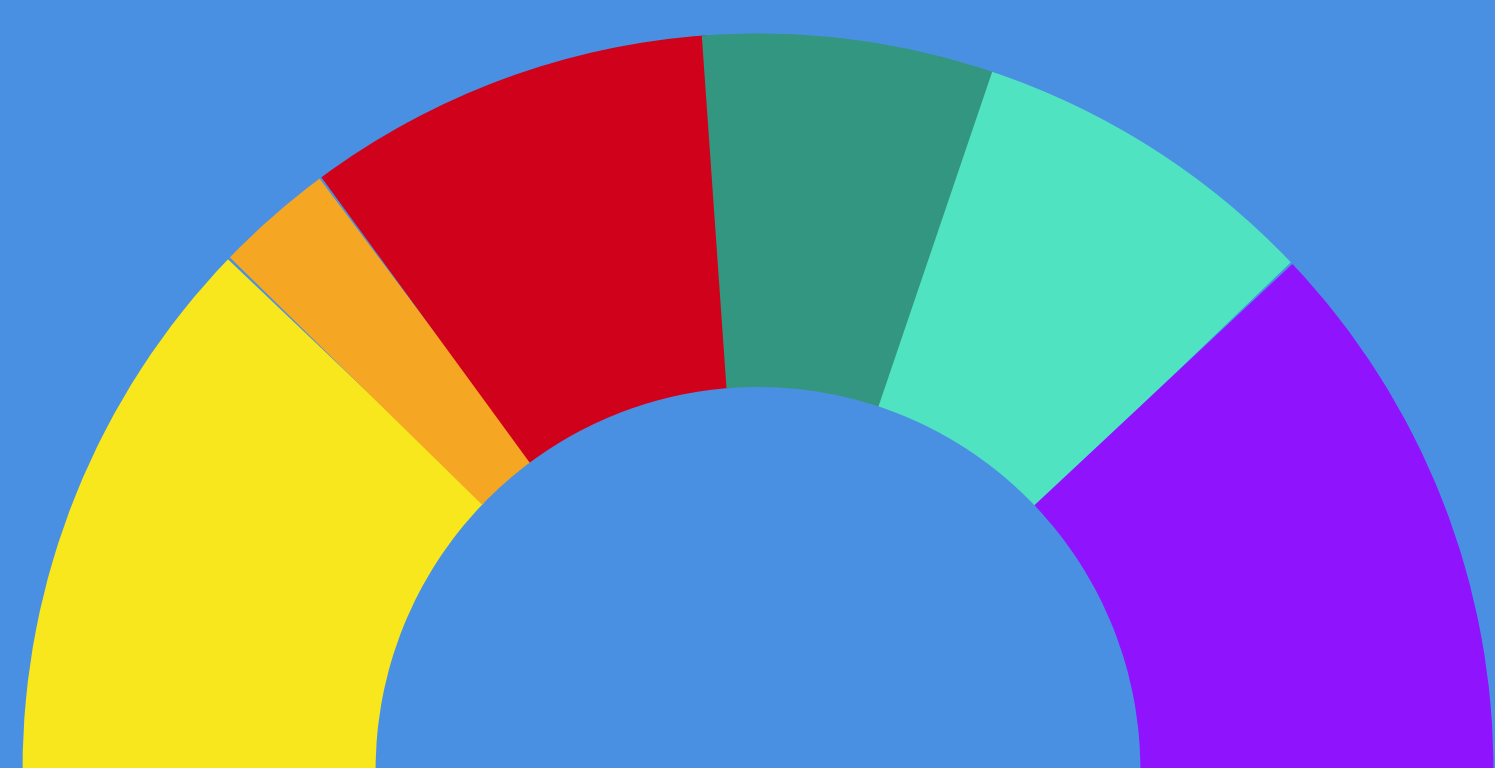
