



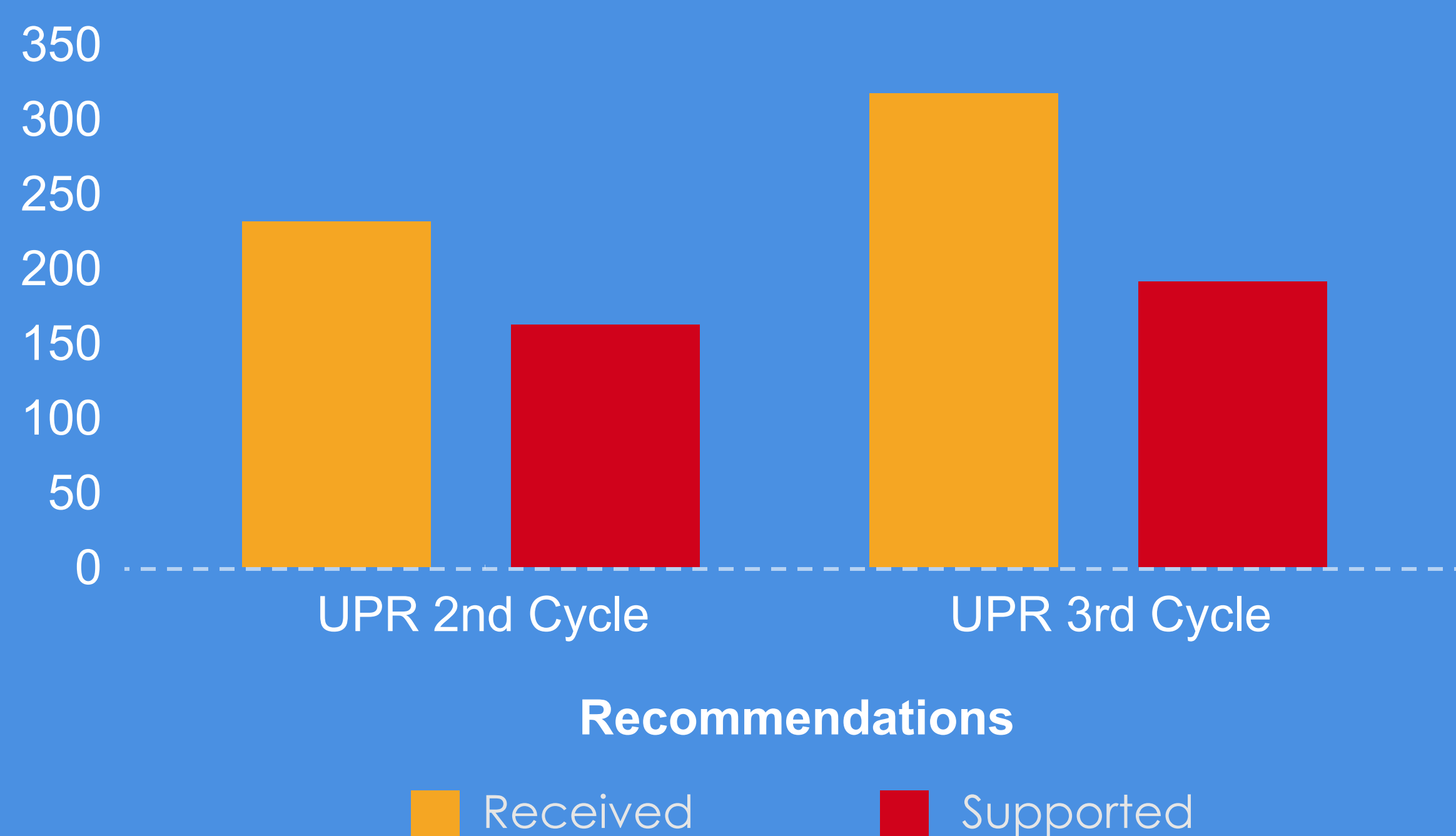

The Universal Periodic Review

The Russian Federation was reviewed by UPR WG 30, in May of 2018. It received 317 recommendations and it supported 191 recommendations at the adoption of its UPR outcome at HRC 39, in September 2018 (an increase of 18% with respect to the 2nd cycle).

Supported recommendations related to: Legal and general framework of implementation, universal and cross-cutting issues, civil and political rights, economic, social, and cultural rights, women's rights, and rights of other vulnerable groups and persons.

Top 5* Sustainable Development Goals



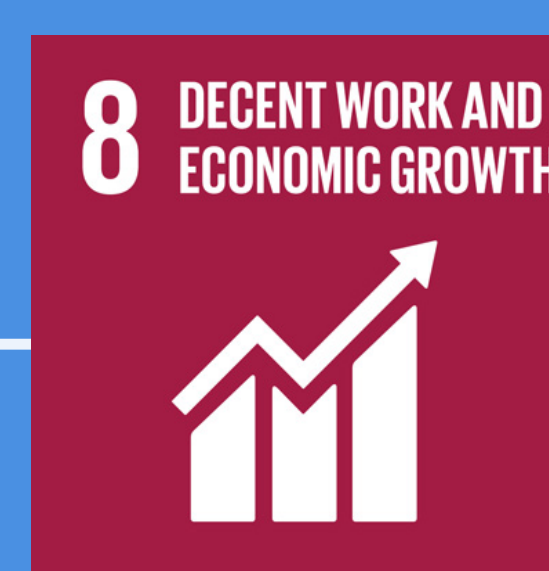

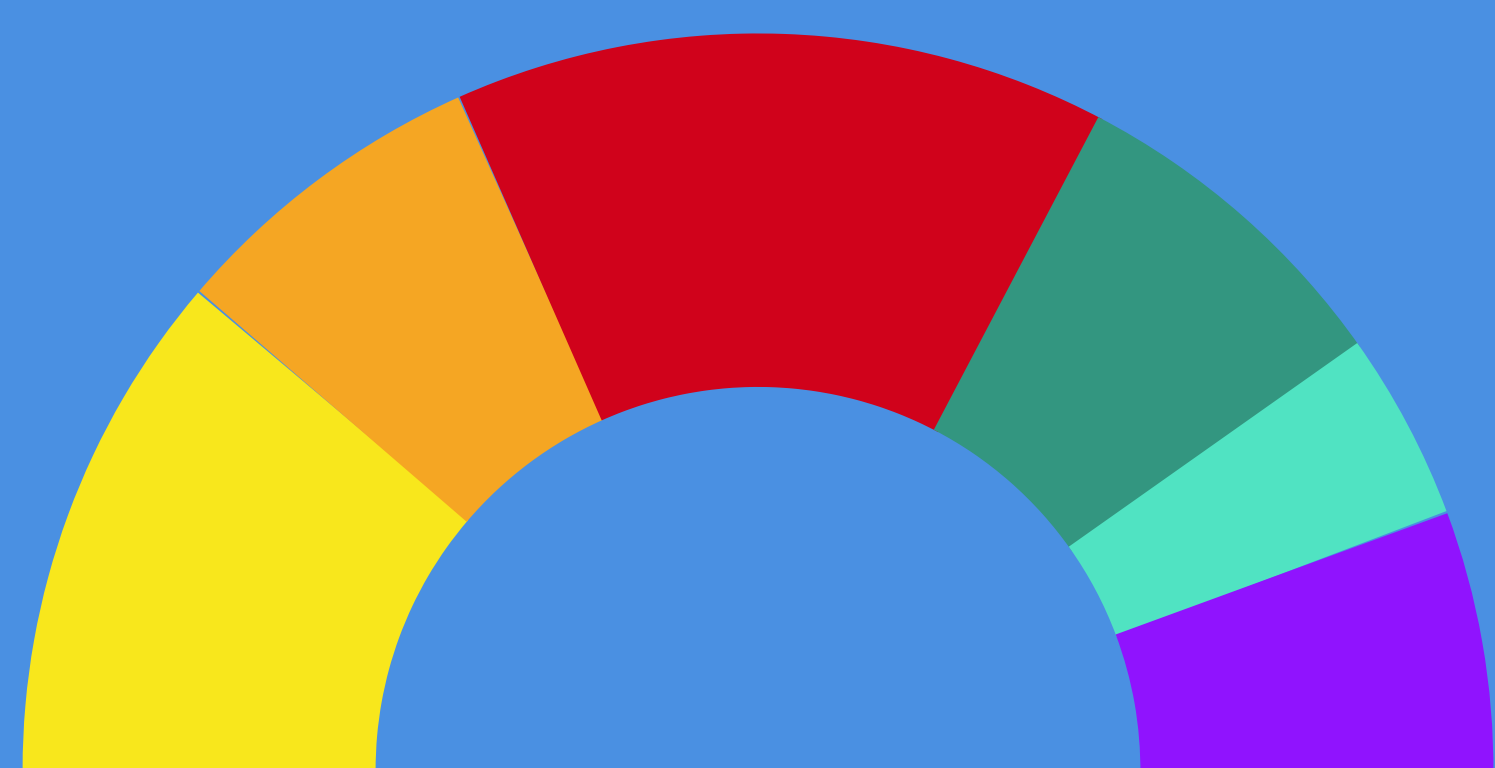
