



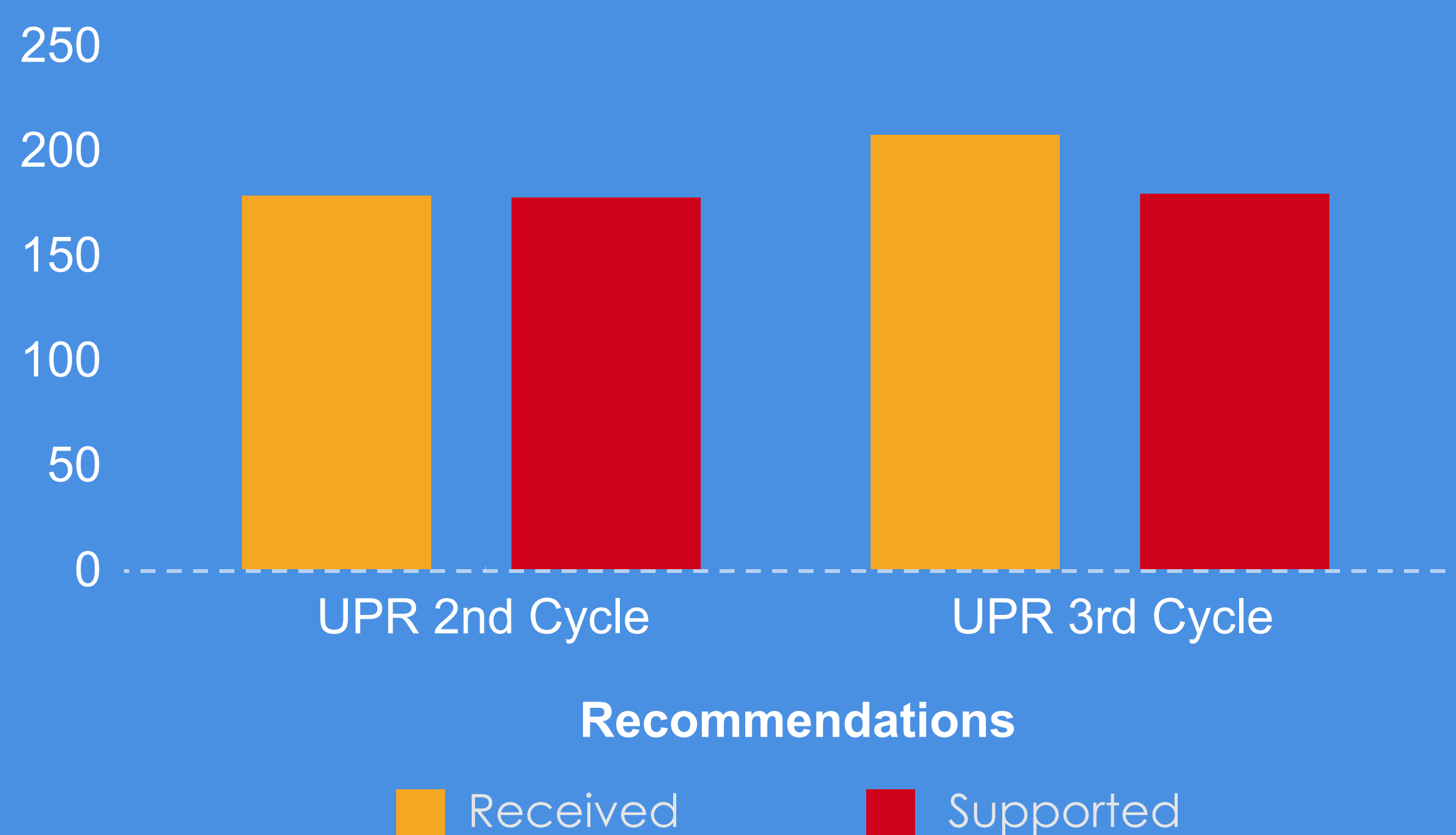
Central African Republic

The Universal Periodic Review

Central African Republic was reviewed by UPR WG 31, in November of 2018. It received 207 recommendations and it supported 179 recommendations at the adoption of its UPR outcome at HRC 40, in March 2019 (an increase of 1% with respect to the 2nd cycle).

Supported recommendations related to: Legal and general framework of implementation, universal and cross-cutting issues, civil and political rights, economic, social, and cultural rights, women's rights, and rights of other vulnerable groups and persons.

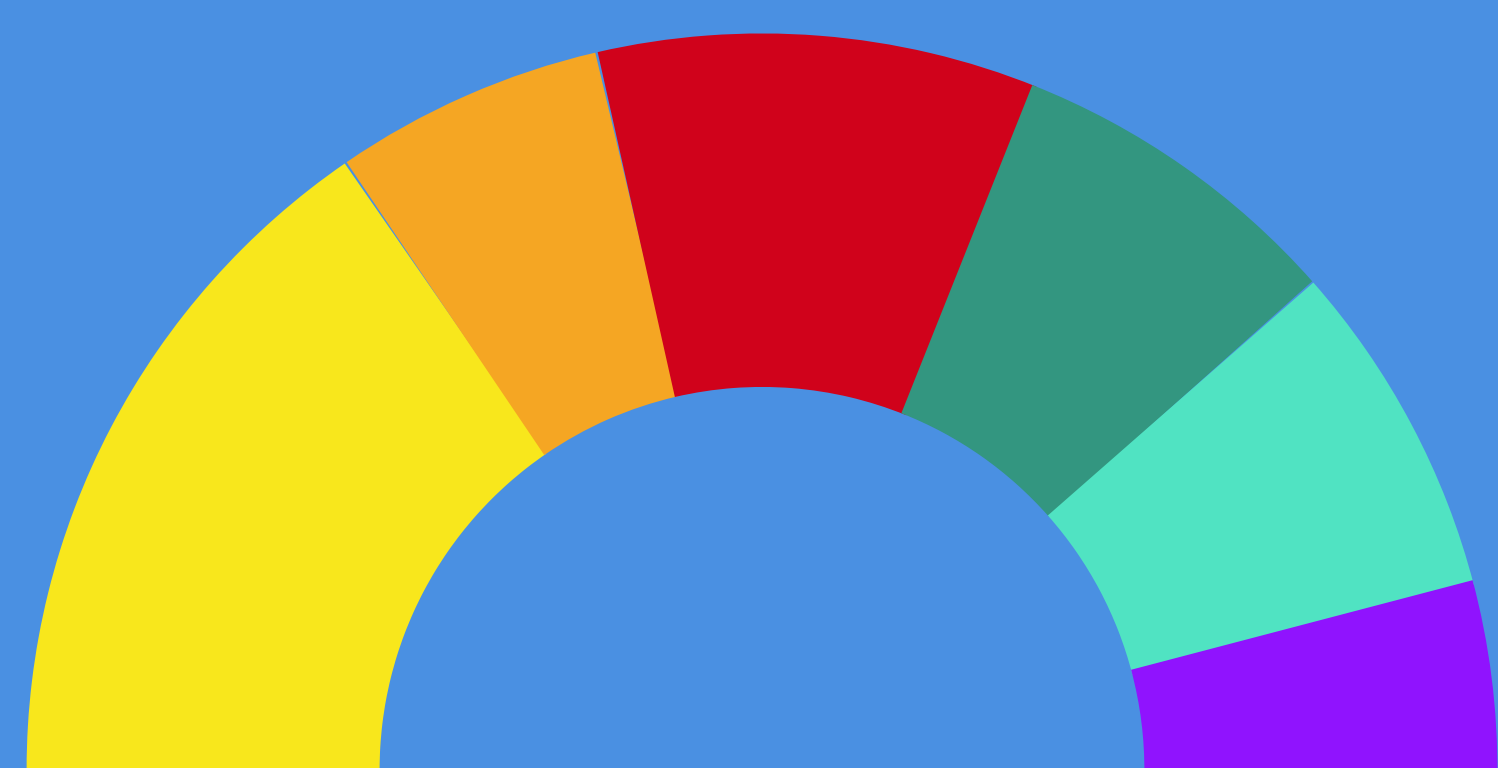
